Course Overview

This course is suitable for students over 19 years of age who wish to improve their Math's skills.

Classes are available from entry level up to level 2 and cover topics including:-

Course Requirements

Students are required to undertake an initial assessment and interview. This will indicate the level of maths and allow an Individual Learning Plan to be drawn up by the tutor to meet each student's individual needs.

Classes are available on various days with students placed in a session relevant to their initial assessment.

Students will need to bring a calculator, pen, paper and folder to each session

Course Progression

Students are able to progress to the next level, if appropriate, or onto GCSE Maths providing they demonstrate an appropriate level of ability.
