## Course Overview

This short course, which leads to a qualification, is ideal for anyone considering a career in volunteering or who wants to volunteer at a local charity or organisation.

The course covers a number of topics including:

- The benefits of volunteering
- The functions of different volunteering organisations
- Personal skills required for volunteering
- Organisational standards and Equal Opportunities

The course is delivered at a comfortable pace by an experienced and supportive tutor.

Successful completion of the course will lead to a NCFE Level 1 Award in Volunteering qualification.

Due to current guidelines governing social distancing, courses may need to be delivered via a combination of online tutorials and classroom based activities.

## Course Requirements

No prior knowledge. Learners will, however, be asked to complete a short written assessment prior to the start of the course.

## Mandatory Units

Learners must complete two units:

- Explore volunteering and the ways to become a Volunteer
- Personal standards and requirements for working in a volunteering role

Learners will need to complete a small portfolio of practical exercises and tasks.
