

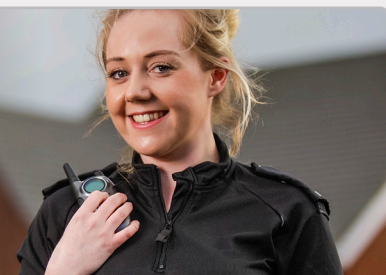


# ARE YOU COLLEGE READY?

## What are the Uniformed Public Services?

The Uniformed Public Services are statutory organisations who work to protect citizens of the UK from threats both domestic and foreign, uphold the law fairly and firmly, provide routine and emergency medical care in emergency situations and to operate within the full force of the laws governing the United Kingdom.



## College Ready Tasks:



### TASK 1

Research a range of different job roles within the Uniformed Public Services - these could be more general roles such as Police Officer, Army Soldier, Fire Fighter, but you may wish to research some more specialised job roles such as Weapons Technician, Counter Terrorism Detective or Chef.



### TASK 2

Outline what your career aspirations are in the Uniformed Public Services, include why you want to join that service, what role you wish to carry out and what your own skills and qualities are which will benefit the organisation.



### TASK 3

Define what statutory and non-statutory organisations are in the UK and provide 5 examples for each.

### TASK 1

These are the Equality Act 2010 and the Human Rights Act 1998. Can you find any other published legislation or guidance that governs and regulates how public services act in pursuit of this duty of service to the public?

### TASK 3

Find **THREE** team-building games that involve no fewer than 4 and no more than 8 people.

How many different forms of the sport of kayaking and canoeing can you list? Include both recreational and competitive disciplines.
