What is Cabin Crew ?

The main role of Cabin Crew is to ensure safety and security on board aircraft and provide excellent customer service. Cabin Crew follow strict procedures and set rules to maintain the safety of the aircraft and everybody in it. They have to remain calm under pressure and be willing to respond appropriately to any challenge that's thrown at them. Cabin Crew are trained to deal with many situations – including First Aid, violent or disruptive passengers, on-board fires, severe turbulence, emergency evacuations – and more.
